Adult social work in Finland, 30 ECTS

Come and explore adult social work in Finland! Häme University of Applied Sciences (HAMK) in Hämeenlinna, Finland will organize a 30 ECTS programme for international students. The programme runs from February 1st till May 24th.

The programme starts with a short introduction and orientation, which is followed by 2 weeks of field visits and getting acquainted with various social services in Finland. Week 8 (Feb. 20th - 24th) is reserved for the annual Wellbeing International week, which brings together lecturers and students from HAMK and our partner universities in different countries. After the International week, there is a 2-week practical placement period.

During weeks 11-18 (March 13th - May 5th), you will participate in a 15 ECTS study module on adult social work. The module includes themes such as: participation and empowerment; preventing marginalization; unemployment, addictions and mental problems; creative methods in social work. The module consists of lectures, workshops, field visits, projects, workplace cooperation etc. During the study module you will be working with Finnish students, but the instruction is provided in English. This helps you to integrate and feel part of the community.

After the module, you will have an opportunity for more practical placement during which you will get hands-on experience of different areas of social work in Finland. We have placement opportunities in mental health and substance misuse services, disability services etc. If you wish, you can also attend a 5 ECTS course on Creative methods in social work.

Prerequisite: Min. 1 year of studies in social work or related field of study

Language requirement: CEFR level B2.1. in English
